

ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1957 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1958 AND APPROPRIATING AND SETTING ASIDE THE NECESSARY FUNDS OUT OF THE GENERAL AND OTHER REVENUES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND FOR THE VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AND IMPROVEMENTS OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of providing the funds necessary and proposed to be expended in the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1957 and ending September 30, 1958, the available resources and revenues of the City of Mesquite for said fiscal year be and the same are hereby appropriated and set aside for the maintenance and operation of the various departments of the City government of the City of Mesquite, as follows:


SECTION 11. The transfer of an unencumbered balance of an appropriation made for the use of a department to another department may be made by the City Council.

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
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A REWARD OF \$250.00 FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF COMMITTING THE CRIME OF ARSON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City of Mesquite, Texas hereby offers a reward of Two Hundred, Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for the arrest and conviction of any person or persons found guilty of committing the crime of ARSON within the corporate limits of the City of Mesquite, Texas. This reward is a standing offer, and shall be paid out of the General Fund of the City of Mesquite, Texas.

SECTION 2. The passage of this ordinance constitutes an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public welfare and safety, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained.
