SECTION 111. That if and when in the judgment of the City Manager, actual and/or probable receipts are less than the amount estimated and herein appropriated for expenditure, the City Manager shall forthwith effect a like reduction in the expenditures of the several departments.

ORDINANCE NO. 184

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A REWARD OF \$250.00 FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF COMMITTING THE CRIME OF ARSON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City of Mesquite, Texas hereby offers a reward of Two Hundred, Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for the arrest and conviction of any person or persons found guilty of committing the crime of ARSON within the corporate limits of the City of Mesquite, Texas. This reward is a standing offer, and shall be paid out of the General Fund of the City of Mesquite, Texas.

SECTION 2. The passage of this ordinance constitutes an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public welfare and safety, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained.
