AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1958 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1959 AND APPROPRIATING AND SETTING ASIDE THE NECESSARY FUNDS OUT OF THE GENERAL AND OTHER REVENUES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND FOR THE VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AND IMPROVEMENTS OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of providing the funds necessary and proposed to be expended in the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1958 and ending September 30, 1958, the available resources and revenues of the City of Mesquite for said fiscal year be and the same are hereby appropriated and set aside for the maintenance and operation of the various departments of the City government of the City of Mesquite, as follows:

SECTION 2. 'That the transfer of an unencumbered balance of an appropriation made for the use of a department to another department may be made by the City Council;

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SECTION 3. That the City Manager may transfer an unneeded surplus in the amount budgeted for one account classification to another within the same department or activity in which a deficiency exists;

SECTION 4. That if and when in the judgment of the City Manager, actual and/or probable receipts are less than the amount estimated and herein appropriated for expenditure, the City Manager shall forthwith effect a like reduction in the expenditures of the several departments.
