

ORDINANCE NO. 224AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE NUMBER OF INHABITANTS OF THE CITY
OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ON JANUARY 1, 1959.

WHEREAS, City Manager C. J. Griggs did on or about January 19, 1959 appoint a committee to conduct a survey of the population within the City Limits of the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of determining a census thereof; said committee consisting of the following:


AND WHEREAS, Leslie G. Brown, Chairman of said Committee, has presented a written report to the City Council of the City of Mesquite in a regular meeting at the regular meeting place on this 3rd day of February, 1959, and reported that a total of 5,685 families resided in the City on January 1, 1959;

AND WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is an average of 3.9 persons per family and that the number of inhabitants of the City of Mesquite on January 1, 1959 was 22,171; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


