

ORDINANCE NO. 237

AN ORDINANCE AGREEMENT WITH DALLAS COUNTY THAT THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS SHALL FURNISH FIRE PROTECTION AND ANSWER ALL FIRE CALLS ADJOINING THE CITY LIMITS OF MESQUITE UPON THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND FOR THE CONSIDERATION SET FORTH IN THE ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF DALLAS COUNTY, PASSED THE 5TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1959.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That for the calendar year of 1959, the City of Mesquite, Texas, contracts with the County of Dallas for said City to furnish fire protection and to answer all fire calls in the area adjoining the corporate limits of said City, as shown on the official fire protection zone map of Dallas County, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, under the terms and conditions and for the considerations set forth in the order of the Commissioners' Court of Dallas County, passed the 5th day of February, 1959, as follows, to-wit:


That a contract be entered into with each and all of the following cities in Dallas County: Balch Springs, Carrollton, Cedar Hill, Cockrell Hill, Coppell, DeSoto, Duncanville, Farmers Branch, Fruitdale, Garland, Grand Prairie, Hutchins, Irving, Lancaster, Mesquite, Richardson, Rowlett, Seagoville and Wilmer, whereby it is agreed that the fire calls in the immediate rural areas adjacent to them contemplated by Article 2341a, Revised Civil Statutes, for a period of (1) one year from this date for the following consideration: Two Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) to be paid to each City entering into this agreement in one payment and a sum of Eighteen Thousand dollars (\$18,000.00) to be set aside by the Commissioners Court of Dallas County to be divided among the participating towns under this order at the end of the year on the basis of the number of alarms answered outside of their respective corporate limits. The total amount to be appropriated by the County of Dallas under this order is not to exceed Sixty Five Thousand and Five Hundred dollars (\$65,500.00).

SECTION 2. That the City Secretary, or Chief of the Fire Department, or Secretary for the Fire Department file with the County Fire Marshal of Dallas County, not later than the fifth of each month a certified copy of a monthly report listing the total number of runs made into the county for the previous month.
