

ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING TITLE I, SECTION 6, OF THE 1948 CITY CODE, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR PLUMBING FEES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3.00 FOR THE FIRST FIXTURE, AND 50¢ FOR EACH ADDITIONAL PLUMBING FIXTURE; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That Title I, Section 6, of the 1948 City Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended so as to provide that the following plumbing fees shall be charged:


"Plumbing-- \$3.00 for the first fixture, 50¢ for each additional fixture."

SECTION 2. Every person, firm or corporation which shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the corporation court shall be assessed a fine not to exceed \$200.00 for each offense.

SECTION 3. The fact that at the present time there is a need for an increase in plumbing fees in the City of Mesquite, and is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, creates an urgency and an emergency, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after the passage and the publication of the caption sheet, as the law and charter in such cases provides.
