ORDINANCE NO. 325

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, LEVYING THE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1960 AT A RATE OF 100 CENTS (\$1.00) PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAX-ABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE AS OF JANUARY 1, 1960, TO PROVIDE REVENUES FOR THE PAYMENT OF CURRENT EXPENSES AND INTEREST AND SINKING FUND REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR DUE AND DELINQUENT DATES TOGETHER WITH PENAL-TIES AND INTEREST; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That there be and is hereby levied for the year 1960 on all taxable property, real, personal and mixed, situated within the corporate limits of the city of Mesquite, and not exempt by the Constitution of the State and valid State laws, a tax of one-hundred cents (\$1.00) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property, and shall be apportioned and distributed as follows:

(A) For the purpose of defraying the current expenses, interest and sinking fund requirements of the municipal government of the City a tax of One Hundred Cents (\$1.00) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property.

Section 2. That all ad valorem taxes shall become due and payable on October 1, 1960, and all ad valorem taxes for the year 1960 shall become delinquent after January 31, 1961. There shall be discount for payment of taxes prior to January 31, 1961 at the rate of three percent (3%) in October, two percent (2%) in November and one percent (1%) in December. If any person fails to pay the ad valorem taxes on or before the 31st day of January, 1961, the following penalties shall be payable thereon, to-wit: During the month of February, one percent (1%), during the month of March, two percent (2%); during the month of April, three percent (3%); during the month of May, four percent (4%); during the month of June, five percent (5%); and on or after the 1st day of July, eight percent (8%).

<u>Section 3.</u> Taxes are payable in Mesquite, Texas at the Office of the Tax Assessor and Collector. The City shall have available all the rights and remedies provided by law for the enforcement of the collection of taxes levied under this ordinance. Page 2 Ordinance No. 325

<u>Section 4.</u> That the tax rolls, as presented to the City Council, together with any supplement thereto, be, and the same are hereby approved.

Section 5. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest at the rateof six percent (6%) per annum, in addition to the penalties provided for herein.

Section 6. The fact that it is necessary that this ordinance be enacted in order to authorize the collection of ad valorem taxes for the year 1960 creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.
