ORDINANCE NO. 384

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, FIXING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SERVICES FURNISHED BY THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY WHE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the rates or charges per month for services furnished by the Sanitary Sewer System shall be as follows:

- (a) Single family residences \$2.00 Duplexes, \$2.00 per dwelling unit; Apartments, \$2.00 per dwelling unit.
- (b) Commercial and business establishments \$2.00 minimum for first 10,000 gallons of water consumed, and prorated at the rate of \$1.00 for each 10,000 gallons of water consumed over and above the first 10,000 gallons of water.

SECTION 2. The fact that the present sewer rates of the City of Mesquite are inadequate requires the adoption of new sewer rates and creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the immediate preservation of the public, business and for the usual daily operation of the municipal departments. It requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately following its passage as the law and charter in such cases provides.
