

ORDINANCE NO. 454

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DIVIDING THE CITY INTO FOUR DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCILMEN TO PLACE NO. 1, PLACE NO. 2, PLACE NO. 3 AND PLACE NO. 4; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Mesquite is hereby divided for the purpose of electing Councilmen for Place No. 1, Place No. 2, Place No. 3 and Place No. 4 into four districts which shall be known as District No. 1, District No. 2, District No. 3 and District No. 4.

District No. 1 shall be comprised of all that portion of the City located North of U. S. Highway 67 as indicated on the map of the City attached hereto and made a part hereof.

District No. 2 shall be comprised of all that portion of the City located South of U. S. Highway 67, North and East of Gross Road, North of Grubb Drive and West of the East corporate limit lines of the City as indicated on the map of the City attached hereto and made a part hereof.

District No. 3 shall be comprised of all that portion of the City located South of U. S. Highway 67, South and West of Gross Road and South Mesquite Creek and Northeast of the western most corporate limit lines of the City as indicated on the map of the City attached hereto and made a part hereof.


District No. 4 shall be comprised of all that portion of the City located South of Grubb Drive, North and East of South Mesquite Creek and North and West of the southerly and easterly most corporate limit lines of the City as indicated on the map of the City attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. Any territory hereafter annexed to the City shall upon annexation become a part of that District described above to which it is attached and in which it is situated.

Section 3. Any phrase, clause, section, sentence of any ordinance or any ordinance in its entirety which is in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed and shall be of no further force and effect.

Section 4. Whereas under the provisions of Article IV Section 4A of the Home Rule Charter of the City it is required that the City shall be divided into four districts equally apportioned as to inhabitants and periodically thereafter as the necessity shall arise in at least 120 days before any Council election, the governing body shall, where necessary by ordinance, alter or change the boundaries of such districts for the purpose of preserving and maintaining the equal apportionment of inhabitants in each such district created an urgency and an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business and in the public health, safety and general welfare of the City requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provides.
