

ORDINANCE NO. 478

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 342 OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST FOUR MEMBERS OF THE CITY PLAN COMMISSION SHALL BE REQUIRED TO MAKE ANY RECOMMENDATIONS, APPROVE SITE PLANS, OR TO TRANSACT ANY OTHER BUSINESS OF THE CITY PLAN COMMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 342 of the City of Mesquite, Texas, duly passed by the City Council on November 21, 1960, be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to hereafter read as follows, to-wit:

"Section 7. Quorum - A majority of the Commission shall constitute a quorum to transact any business, and the affirmative vote of at least four members shall be required to make any recommendation to the City Council, to approve any site plans filed with it for its approval, and to transact any other business before the City Plan Commission."

Section 2. Whereas, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 342 of the City of Mesquite, Texas, in order to clarify Section 7 thereof, in protection of the public interest, comfort and welfare of the City of Mesquite and creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
