AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE VI, SECTION 10-61.2 OF THE MESQUITE CITY CODE OF 1960 SO AS TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF ANY VEHICLE ON NORTH GALLOWAY FROM THE TEXAS & PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY TO BELT LINE WYE, ON GUS THOMASSON ROAD FROM BELT LINE WYE TO U. S. HIGHWAY 80, ON GUS THOMASSON ROAD FROM U. S. HIGHWAY 67 TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS LINE OF THE CITY, AND ON OATES DRIVE FROM THE ALLEY EAST OF OLEANDER TRAIL TO THE ALLEY WEST OF MODLIN STREET; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10, Article VI, Section 10-61.2 of the Mesquite City Code of 1960 be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Gus Thomasson Road from Belt Line Wye to U. S. Highway 80.

Gus Thomasson Road from U. S. Highway 67 to the North Corporate Limits line of the City.

North Galloway from the Texas & Pacific Railroad right of way to Belt Line Wye.

Oates Drive from the alley East of Oleander Trail to the alley West of Modlin Street.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction in Corporation Court be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and subject to the penalties contained in Section 1.6 of the Mesquite City Code of 1960.

SECTION 3. The fact that it is necessary to prohibit parking along certain sections of North Galloway, Gus Thomasson Road and Oates Drive due to the increase of traffic creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such cases provide.
