ORDINANCE NO. 529

---

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE AMENDING THE MESQUITE CITY CODE OF 1960 BY AMENDING SECTION 10-61.2 SO AS TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF ANY VEHICLE AT ANY TIME WHEN SIGNS ARE ERECTED OR CURBS MARKED GIVING NOTICE THEREOF ON SUMMIT STREET, NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE, FROM THE WEST CURB LINE OF GUS THOMASSON ROAD TO A POINT 342 FEET WEST; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 10-61.2 of Article VI, Chapter 10 of the Mesquite City Code of 1960 be, and the same is hereby, amended by adding thereto the following:

"Section 10-61.2. Parking at any time prohibited on certain designated streets.

When signs are erected or curbs marked giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets, or portions thereof, described as follows:

Summit Street, North and South side, from the west curb line of Gus Thomasson Road to a point 342 feet West."

SECTION 2. That all other provisions of Section 10-61.2 of the Mesquite City Code of 1960 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in corporation court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances of the City do not adequately regulate the parking of vehicles on a portion of Summit Street creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such cases provide.
