

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE VI, OF THE MESQUITE CITY CODE OF 1960 SO AS TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF ANY VEHICLE ON THE EAST SIDE OF SOUTH BRYAN STREET FROM EAST GROSS STREET TO EAST HOLLEY STREET; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Chapter 10, Article VI, of the Mesquite City Code of 1960 be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following Section which shall read as follows, to-wit:

"Where signs are erected or curbs marked giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 8 A. M. and 5 P. M. Mondays through Fridays, inclusive, upon the street or any portion thereof described as follows:

South Bryan Street, East side, from East Gross Street to East Holley Street."

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction in Corporation Court be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense, and subject to the penalty contained in Section 1.6 of the Mesquite City Code of 1960.


Section 3. The fact that it is necessary to prohibit parking along a certain section of South Bryan Street due to the increase of traffic during school hours creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such cases provide.
