

ORDINANCE NO. 678

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE AMENDING SECTION 2-11 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, 1960, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR A PLANNING COMMISSION CONSISTING OF SEVEN MEMBERS AND TWO ALTERNATE MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SERVICE BY ALTERNATE MEMBERS IN THE ABSENCE OF REGULAR MEMBERS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 2-11 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, 1960, be, and the same is hereby amended so that said Section 2-11 shall hereafter provide as follows, to-wit:

"The Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) members and two (2) alternate members, and shall be appointed by the City Council. The alternate members shall serve in the absence of regular members, and when serving in the absence of regular members shall be authorized to perform all the powers and duties of such regular members. The Planning Commission shall elect a chairman, vice-chairman and secretary. The chairman shall call and preside at all meetings. The vice-chairman shall carry out the duties of the chairman in the absence of the chairman. The secretary shall keep minutes of all meetings."

SECTION 2. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not provide for alternate members to the City Planning Commission, and the fact that such alternate members are needed in order to assure the presence of the required number of members at meetings of the Planning Commission creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.
