

ORDINANCE NO. 700

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN JOB TITLE FOR PERSONS SERVING AS POLICE CAPTAINS, FROM THE TITLE OF POLICE CAPTAIN TO DEPUTY CHIEF OF POLICE, BY ABOLISHING THE JOB TITLE OF POLICE CAPTAIN, AND PROVIDING THAT ALL PERSONS HAVING THE JOB TITLE OF POLICE CAPTAIN PRIOR TO PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL HENCEFORTH HOLD THE JOB TITLE OF DEPUTY CHIEF OF POLICE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the job title of Police Captain is, and the same shall hereby be, changed to that of Deputy Chief of Police.

SECTION 2. That the job title of Police Captain is, and the same shall hereby be, abolished.

SECTION 3. That all persons holding the job title of Police Captain prior to the passage of this ordinance shall henceforth have the job title of Deputy Chief of Police.
