

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROHIBITING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, EAST OR WEST BOUND ON FRONT STREET, FROM MAKING A LEFT TURN ON TO NORTH GALLOWAY AVENUE; BY DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO CAUSE TO BE ERECTED AT THE LOCATIONS AFORESAID APPROPRIATE SIGNS GIVING NOTICE OF THE PROHIBITION; BY PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That vehicular traffic, east or west bound on Front Street, shall be prohibited from making a left turn on to North Galloway Avenue.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager and Chief of Police are hereby directed to cause to be erected adequate signs to give the public notice that vehicular traffic is prohibited from making left turns at the locations stated in SECTION 1 hereof.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction in Corporation Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two-Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.


SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to control vehicular traffic at the locations stated in SECTION 1 hereof creates an emergency in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its date of passage as the laws of the State and the City Charter of Mesquite in such cases provide.
