## ORDINANCE CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

THE STATE OF TEXAS : COUNTY OF DALLAS : CITY OF MESQUITE :

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City duly ordered an election to be held in said City on the 28th day of June, 1969, on the PROPOSI-TIONS hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council.

1. That the City Council officially finds and determines that only resident, qualified electors who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation were allowed to vote at said election, and that the following votes were cast at said election on the PROPOSITIONS submitted:
