

ORDINANCE NO. 823

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A REVISED SALARY PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1969, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1970, BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH REVISED SALARY PLAN SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AS OF THE FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER 1969; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby adopted for the City of Mesquite a Revised Salary Plan for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 1969, and ending September 30, 1970. That such revised salary plan shall apply to the job classifications and monthly rates of salary as set-forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all intents and purposes.


SECTION 2. That such Revised Salary Plan as hereinabove adopted shall become effective from and after October 1, 1969.

SECTION 3. That the present salary plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide stability and continuity of employment among city employees performing essential city services constitutes an urgency and an emergency in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare and makes necessary that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its date of passage and publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.


