ORDINANCE CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City duly ordered an election to be held in said City on the 7th day of February, 1970, on the PROPOSI-TIONS hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that a case of emergency or urgent public necessity exists which requires the holding of the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed, such emergency or urgent public necessity being that the proceeds from the proposed bonds are required as soon as possible and without delay for necessary and urgently needed public improvements; that said meeting was open to the public as required by law; and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Chapter 227, Acts of the 61st Legislature, Regular Session, 1969.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

- 1. That the City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling this said election.
- 2. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at the election on each submitted PROPOSITION by the resident, qualified electors who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, and who voted at the election:

- That, as covenanted and agreed in the Ordinance passed on January 19, 1970, calling the aforesaid election, and since each of said PROPOSITIONS so submitted has carried, the bonds voted on June 28, 1969, for the identical purpose and in the identical amount as stated in each PROPOSITION shall never be issued or delivered, and the authority for the issuance thereof has been and is hereby cancelled and shall be void, and said convenant and agreement shall be a permanent and binding contract with the electorate of the City of Mesquite.
