

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 729 OF SAID CITY, THE SAME BEING THE CIVIL SERVICE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE: BY PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 10.4 OF THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; BY RETAINING IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT ALL PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 729 NOT SPECIFICALLY AMENDED HEREBY; BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH AMENDATORY ORDINANCE OF JANUARY 1, 1971; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Civil Service Rules of the City of Mesquite, Texas, heretofore adopted pursuant to Ordinance 729 of said City, shall be, and the same are hereby amended by substituting a revised Section 10.4 of said Rules; said revised Section 10.4 of the Civil Service Rules of the City of Mesquite, Texas, being attached hereto, and made a part of this ordinance as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That all provisions of Ordinance No. 729 not specifically amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That the amendment hereby adopted shall become effective from and after the 1st day of January, 1971.

Section 4. That the present ordinances of the City are inadequate to provide an adequate vacation schedule for the employees of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and an emergency in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare and necessitates that this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases permits.
