

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 10-61.2 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY PROHIBITING PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF HOLLEY STREET FROM SOUTH GALLOWAY AVENUE TO BRYAN STREET; BY DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO CAUSE TO BE POSTED ADEQUATE SIGNS TO NOTIFY THE PUBLIC THAT PARKING AT SUCH LOCATION IS PROHIBITED; BY PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION BY THE CITY MANAGER OF LOADING ZONES AT SAID LOCATION; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 10-61.2 of the City Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Parking is prohibited on both sides of Holley Street from South Galloway Avenue to Bryan Street.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to cause to be posted adequate signs to notify the public that parking at the aforesaid location is prohibited.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is authorized to designate certain areas at the location aforesaid as loading zones.

SECTION 4. That it is the intent of the City Council that this ordinance be deemed severable and in the event that any provision hereof shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provisions of this ordinance left standing nor any other ordinances of the City of Mesquite.


SECTION 5. That any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 6. That the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to properly regulate parking on Holley Street between South Galloway Avenue and Bryan Street constitutes an urgency and an emergency in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, and necessitates that the


