

ORDINANCE NO. 883

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF AN EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN, PROVIDING FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT SUCH PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the employees Classification and Salary Plan, as attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance as Exhibit "A", shall be, and the same is, hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to allocate adequate monies by which to implement the Classification and Salary Plan hereinabove adopted.

SECTION 3. That the Classification and Salary Plan adopted by this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the first day of January, 1971.

SECTION 4. That the present employees Classification and Salary Plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide stability and continuity in the employment of essential employees creates an urgency and an emergency in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare and necessitates that this Ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
