

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 878; AMENDING THE 1970-71 BUDGET FOR SAID PERIOD AND ADOPTING SAID AMENDED BUDGET AND PROVIDING THE DATE UPON WHICH SAME WILL TAKE EFFECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has by ordinance, heretofore, adopted the 1970-71 budget for the City of Mesquite thereby providing funds for the operation of the various service departments for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1970, and ending September 30, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved additional expenditures subsequent to the approval of such budget, and additional expenditures represented by salary increases for municipal employees and additional capital outlay in various functions; and

WHEREAS, a reallocation of the funds originally appropriated in said 1970-71 budget is necessary in order to meet the financial requirements of the various operating departments of the City for the remainder of the budget term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the amended budget, as attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, is hereby adopted as the budget of the City of Mesquite through the remainder of the fiscal year.

SECTION 2. That the necessity for the making and approving of an amended budget for the fiscal year 1970-71, as required by the laws of the State of Texas, creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its date of passage, as the law in such cases provides.


