

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 438, AND SECTION 14A-8, CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, BY PROVIDING THAT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF APPEAL AND BOARD OF PLUMBERS HERETOFORE APPOINTED BY THE CITY MANAGER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 438, Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, and Chapter 14A, Section 8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, are hereby amended to provide that the members of the Board of Appeal and members of the Board of Plumbers heretofore provided by such ordinances to be appointed by the City Manager shall be appointed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite; in all other respects such ordinances to remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 2. That any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the Ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not provide for the appointment of members of the Board of Appeal and Board of Plumbing by the City Council creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.


