ORDINANCE NO. 1008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMEND-ING SECTION 9-7 OF THE MESQUITE CITY CODE, DELETING THE PRESENT SECTION AND INSERTING A NEW SECTION THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-7 of the Mesquite City Code, otherwise referred to as the sanitation rate ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the present section in its entirety and the replacement thereof with the following new section:

"There shall be charged, assessed and collected from each person within the City the following monthly service charges for garbage refuse, trash and rubbish collection and disposal:

- "(a) For a one-family residence, the charge shall be Two and 50/100's Dollars (\$2.50) per month for collections;
- "(b) For an apartment residence, the charge shall be Two and 50/100's Dollars (\$2.50) per month for each apartment for collections. Provided, however, that the charge for units using a central pickup station shall be One and 25/100's Dollars (\$1.25) per month;
- "(c) For regular mercantile establishments, boarding houses and apartment residences having central garbage storage facilities, the charge shall be Six Dollars (\$6.00) per month for collections.

SECTION 2. The fact that the present sanitation collection rates of the City of Mesquite are inadequate requires the adoption of new sanitation collection rates and creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the daily operation of the municipal departments. It requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.
