ORDINANCE NO. 1016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 703, BY PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE JOB CLASSIFICATION OF POLICE LIEUTENANT; BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH POSITION AS IS HEREBY CREATED, SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AS A POSITION IN THE CLASSIFIED POLICE SERVICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 1269m V.A.C.S.; BY PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF POSITIONS WITHIN SUCH CLASSIFICATION AS IS HEREBY CREATED; BY ESTABLISHING A PAY PLAN FOR SUCH CLASSIFIED POSITION; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service Commission has determined the need for the classification of Police Lieutenant in the Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 703, duly passed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, on the 23rd day of October, 1967, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

- A. CLASSIFICATION CREATED - That the job classification of Police Lieutenant is hereby created. That such position is hereby established as a classified position within the Police Service of the City of Mesquite, in accordance with Article 1269m V.A.C.S.
- B. NUMBER OF POSITIONS - That the following number of positions are hereby established within the job classification hereinabove created; to wit:

- C. PAY RATE - That the job classification herein established shall be compensated at the following pay rate:

SECTION 2. That it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that the provisions of this Ordinance be deemed severable, and should any such provision be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not effect those provisions of this Ordinance left standing nor any other of the Ordinances of the City of Mesquite.


