

ORDINANCE NO. 1045

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A REVISED SALARY PLAN FOR THE BALANCE OF THE FISCAL YEAR OF 1972; BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH REVISED SALARY PLAN SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE 1ST DAY OF JULY, 1972; BY APPROPRIATING AND SETTING ASIDE OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND AND OTHER REVENUES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, ADEQUATE MONIES FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE REVISED SALARY PLAN; BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH SALARY PLAN IS SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE PRESIDENT'S ECONOMIC STABILIZATION PAY BOARD; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby adopted for the City of Mesquite, a Revised Salary Plan for the balance of the fiscal year of 1972. That such Revised Salary Plan shall apply to the job classifications and monthly rates of salary as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 2. That such Revised Salary Plan as hereinabove adopted shall become effective on the 1st day of July, 1972.

SECTION 3. That adequate monies shall be appropriated from the General Fund and other revenues of the City of Mesquite to provide for the operation and maintenance of the Revised Salary Plan herein adopted; and the City Manager is hereby directed to make appropriate allocations for this purpose.

SECTION 4. That such Revised Salary Plan is subject to the approval of the President's Economic Stabilization Pay Board.




public health, safety, and welfare and makes necessary that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its date of passage and publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
