ORDINANCE NO. 1072

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE WAIVER OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OVER THE WITHIN DESCRIBED LAND AND AGREEING AND CONSENTING TO THE ANNEXATION OF SAME BY THE CITY OF DALLAS, TEXAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas, and the City of Dallas, Texas, share overlapping extraterritorial jurisdiction over certain land; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas, Texas, has indicated a desire to annex said land; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is in accord with such annexation by the City of Dallas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby agree and consent to the annexation by the City of Dallas of the land described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and waives its extraterritorial jurisdiction thereto in favor of the City of Dallas.

SECTION 2. The fact that the land described herein is not subject to the municipal regulation of any municipality creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the welfare of the citizens of the City of Mesquite and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage and publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
