ORDINANCE NO.1097

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 10-61.6, DECLARING IT UNLAWFUL TO PARK OR STAND A VEHICLE FOR MORE THAN TWO (2) HOURS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE 100 BLOCK OF WEST MAIN STREET; BY PROVIDING THAT NOTICE IS GIVEN BY THE POSTING OF SIGNS OR MARKING OF CURBS; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by adding a new section 10-61.6 to read as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

"When notice is given by the erection of signs or the marking of curbs to such effect it shall be unlawful to park or stand a vehicle for a period of more than two (2) hours on the following streets or portions thereof:

"WEST MAIN STREET, both sides of the 100 block."

SECTION 2. Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.
