ORDINANCE NO. 1156

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A TAXI CAB STAND AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MARK SAID LOCATION AND PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the following location is hereby designated as a taxi cab stand and the City Manager is authorized to indicate such designation by appropriate signs or by painting the curb or both:

South side of West Main Street in front of and along the entire length of the property known as 206 West Main.

SECTION 2. When such location is marked by painting the curb or by signs, parking of vehicles other than officially licensed taxi cabs is prohibited.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are, hereby repealed, and all other ordinances of the City of Mesquite not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for by the Code of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 6. The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to provide for the public safety and welfare creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and Charter in such cases provide.
