ORDINANCE NO. 1172

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, THE HONORABLE BOB BEARD, TO EXECUTE A DEED CONVEYING LANCASTER STREET BETWEEN MAIN AND DAVIS STREETS TO THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK; AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A WARRANTY DEED TO CERTAIN ALLEY RIGHT OF WAY AND A QUIT CLAIM DEED ABANDONING CERTAIN UTILITY EASEMENT; ALL AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBITS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 21, 1974, a public hearing was held for the purpose of determining the advisability of closing Lancaster Street between Main and Davis and subsequent thereto an ordinance was adopted determining that the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City required the closing of said street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain alley right of way and utility easement will not be needed by the City of Mesquite after the removal of buildings in the vicinity and that it will be in the public interest to exchange said alley right of way and utility easement for needed right of way for the improvement of College Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Mesquite is hereby authorized to execute a Warranty Deed to the First National Bank of Mesquite conveying that land comprising Lancaster Street between Main and Davis Streets and described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto in consideration of the sum of Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy and no/100's Dollars (\$8,970.00).

SECTION 2. The said Mayor is further authorized to execute a Warranty Deed to that land located in the City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, and described as Alley Right of Way in Volume 5518, Page 9 of the Dallas County Plat Records, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and to execute a Quit Claim Deed relinquishing and abandoning an easement described at the same page and volume and shown on Exhibit "B" attached hereto in exchange for needed right of way on the north side of College Street between Gibson and Galloway Streets and being approximately a ten (10) foot strip along the length of the land belonging to the First National Bank of Mesquite.

Provided, however, that such conveyances shall not take place until provision is made for servicing existing buildings with utilities and sanitation services or such service is no longer needed in the case of the alley and easement and in the case of Lancaster Street, until signs or barricades are erected indicating said street is closed.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. The fact that the continued use of said through street causes a traffic hazard creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public safety, health and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.






