ORDINANCE NO. 1181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING THE REQUIREMENT IN THE LAST PARAGRAPH OF SECTION 210-7 OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1971 EDITION FOR GROUND-FAULT CIRCUIT PROTECTION FOR PERSONNEL; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Mesquite is amended by adding a new Section 7-1.1 entitled deletions which shall read as follows; in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

"Section 7-1.1. Deletions

"The last paragraph of Section 210-7 of the National Electrical Code, 1971 Edition, adopted by the City of Mesquite and requiring ground-fault circuit protection for personnel is hereby deleted."

SECTION 2. Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.


