## ORDINANCE NO. 1219

CASE 1605-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS. AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1973, DULY PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1973, SO AS TO GRANT A CONDI-TIONAL USE DESIGNATION FOR AN ELECTRICAL POWER SUBSTATION USE FOR THAT LAND DESCRIBED AS PART OF TRACT 3, ABSTRACT NO. 1603 AND FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART OF THIS ORDINANCE; BY REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND RETAIN-ING IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT ALL PROVISIONS OF THE 1973 COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE NOT IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; BY PROVIDING THAT THE FOREGOING ZONING CHANGE IS GRANTED SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CURRENT AND FUTURE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCES; BY PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Mesquite and the governing body of the City of Mesquite, in compliance with the Charter of the City of Mesquite and State Laws with reference to granting of zoning changes under the Zoning Ordinance Regulations and Zoning Map, have given the requisite notice by publication and otherwise and, after holding due hearings and affording a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally and to the persons interested and situated in the area, the City of Mesquite is of the opinion that the said change of zoning should be granted herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973 duly passed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas on the 4th day of September 1973, be, and the same

is hereby amended by amending the Zoning Map of the City of Mesquite so as to grant a change of zoning on the property described in Exhibit "A", as attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, by granting a conditional use designation as an electrical power substation.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are, hereby repealed, and all other ordinances of the City of Mesquite not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That the property described in Exhibit "A" shall be used only in the manner and for the purpose provided for by the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973.

SECTION 4. That the foregoing zoning change shall be and it is, granted subject to any development of the land herein being developed in conformity with the requirements of current and/or future drainage improvements ordinances of the City of Mesquite, including Ordinance No. 858 of the Mesquite City Code.

SECTION 5. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision hereof other than the part as decided tobe invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional and shall not affect the validity of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 6. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973 of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 7. Whereas, the property described in Exhibit "A" requires that it be given the above zoning classification in order to permit its proper development and in order to protect the public interest, comfort, and general welfare of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and
