AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 203 OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, BY CHANGING THE NAME OF THE HOSPITAL AUTHORITY CREATED THEREBY TO MESQUITE HOSPITAL AUTHORITY; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS HAS DETERMINED THAT THE NAME OF THE HOSPITAL AUTHORITY CREATED BY ORDINANCE NO. 203 SHOULD BE CHANGED;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 203 of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by deleting Section 3 thereof and inserting a new Section 3 to read as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

3. The name of said Authority shall be Mesquite Hospital Authority.

SECTION 2. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional and shall not affect the validity of Ordinance No. 203 as a whole.

SECTION 3. The fact that the change in name of the existing hospital authority is needed for marketability of bonds creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
