ORDINANCE NO. 1247

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,  
CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS AND  
PORTIONS THEREOF AND ESTABLISHING THE SPEED  
LIMIT THEREON; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY  
CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED  
\$200.00; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the names of the following named  
streets and portions thereof as described below are hereby  
changed to the names indicated, to wit:

<u>EXISTING NAME</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>NEW NAME</u>
1. Lake June Road	From Belt Line Road to Bruton Road	Bruton Lane West
2. Lake June Road	From Bruton Road east to Cartwright Rd.	Bruton Road
3. Lake June Road	From Cartwright Road east to Pioneer Road	Bruton Lane East
4. Cartwright Road	Lake June Road east to Pioneer Road	Bruton Road

SECTION 2. That the speed limits applicable to the  
portions of streets under their existing names shall be contin-  
ued and likewise applicable to such streets under their new  
names.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, sub-division, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.


SECTION 5. The fact that the existing names of these streets cause confusion in locating addresses thereon creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
