ORDINANCE NO. 1255

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT TO THE HEREINBELOW DESCRIBED POSITION WITHIN THE CLASSIFIED POLICE SERVICE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; TO WIT: THE ABOLITION OF ONE POSITION OF POLICE SERGEANT EFFECTIVE AUGUST 15, 1975; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. POSITIONS ABOLISHED - CREATED

That one position of Police Sergeant heretofore created in the classified police service of the City of Mesquite shall be, and the same is, hereby abolished effective August 15, 1975.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

That it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that the provisions of this Ordinance be deemed severable and in the event any such provisions shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provisions of this ordinance left standing nor any of the other ordinances of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY

That the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to provide necessary supervisory positions in the Police Department creates an urgency and an emergency in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare and necessitates that this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
