ORDINANCE NO. 1301

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14A OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ALLOWING THE USE OF POLYVINYL CHLORIDE (PVC) SEWER PIPE MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF ASTM D 3033 OR 3034; BY ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STANDARDS THEREFORE; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 14A, Article X, Section 101 is hereby amended by deleting Paragraph (b) and substituting the following, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

"(b) The building (house) sewer beginning three (3) feet outside of the building wall or foundation shall be vitrified clay, cast iron, asbestos cement, or polyvinyl chloride (PVC) sewer pipe. PVC pipe and fittings shall meet the requirements of ASTM D 3033 or D 3034.

SECTION 2. That Chapter 14A, Article XVII, Section 164, is amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

There is added to Table 10 the following:

"Nonmetallic Pipe: A.S.T.M.
Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) D 3033, D 3034"

SECTION 3. Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is inadequate for the necessary public interest and general welfare, creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
