

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY OF MESQUITE FIRE AND POLICE CLASSIFICATION PLAN BY ADDING ONE POLICE SERGEANT POSITION AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH FIRE AND POLICE CLASSIFICATION PLAN SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that certain revisions to the Fire and Police Classification Plan are necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Fire and Police Classification Plan is hereby amended by adding one Police Sergeant position.


SECTION 2. That this amendment to the Fire and Police Classification Plan of the City of Mesquite is hereby adopted, and shall be effective from and after the passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That the present Fire and Police Classification Plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide stability and continuity in the employment of essential employees creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
