

ORDINANCE NO. 1389

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER TEN OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ESTABLISHING AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AS OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, BY PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter Ten, Section 10-33.12 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

It is hereby expressly provided that the traffic control devices at the following locations are official traffic control devices of the City of Mesquite and the same are hereby authorized as such and shall be deemed to have been officially placed thereat under authority of the governing body of the City of Mesquite.

<u>Traffic Control Device</u>	<u>Location</u>
1. Stop Sign	Agnew Street at Bryan-Belt Line Road
2. Stop Sign	Tripp Road at Belt Line Road

SECTION 2. That should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to properly authorize and designate traffic control devices in the City creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and

requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.


