ORDINANCE NO. 1409

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 1225 BY
ESTABLISHING THE DURATION OF VALIDITY OF
PRIVATE CLUB LICENSES; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 1225 as passed
and approved on December 2, 1974, is hereby amended as follows,
in all other respects said ordinance to remain in full force
and effect:

"Section 2. There is hereby established an
annual license fee for private clubs in the amount
of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) per
establishment to help defray the expense of inspec-
tion and policing of such establishments. Said
License shall be for a period of one year from date
of issue and shall be non-transferrable and the license
fee shall not be prorated. Such license fee shall be
in addition to any other license fees that may be
required and shall not be construed to be a license to
permit dancing."

SECTION 2. The fact that there is insufficient control
over the licensing of Private Clubs for the necessary pro-
tection of the public comfort and general welfare creates an
urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public
health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance
shall take effect immediately from its passage and publica-
tion as the law in such cases provides.


