AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF AN EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN BY ADDING A FIVE PERCENT (5%) COST OF LIVING INCREASE TO EACH CLASSIFICATION; PROVIDING THAT SUCH EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE LST DAY OF APRIL, 1978; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City Council in adoption of the 1977-78 budget provided funds for a five percent (5%) cost of living increase effective April 1st, 1978; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to implement such increase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Revised Employees Classification and Salary Plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. That the Classification and Salary Plan adopted by this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the first day of April, 1978.

SECTION 3. That the present Employees Classification and Salary Plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide stability and continuity in the employment of essential employees creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this Ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
