AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS BY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1225 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1409 BOTH RELATING TO LICENSING AND REGULATION OF PRIVATE CLUBS; and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance Numbers 1225 and 1409 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The fact that the provisions of the aforesaid ordinances are in conflict with the statutes of the State of Texas and thus place an undue burden on the public welfare creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
