

ORDINANCE NO. 1479

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 10-68 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS BY DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF BIG TOWN BOULEVARD BETWEEN INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 30 AND THE SOUTH CITY LIMITS AS A TRUCK ROUTE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 10-68, Chapter 10 of the code of the city of Mesquite, Texas is hereby amended as follows; in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

"(a) The following streets and parts of streets are designated "truck routes" under this article:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Big Town Boulevard	Between Interstate Highway 30 and the South City Limits

All other streets and parts of streets to remain as designated."


SECTION 2. That should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Article 10-68, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not designate the street and limits named herein as a truck route, creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such case provide:


