

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A CURB LOADING ZONE ON A PORTION OF THE WEST SERVICE ROAD OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 635; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the following location be and is hereby designated a loading zone:

On and along the west curb line of the west service road of Interstate Highway 635 from a point 260 feet south of the south curb line of Town East Boulevard to a point 1575 feet south of said curb line.

SECTION 2. That any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction in the Municipal Court, be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.


SECTION 3. That the fact that the ordinance of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to regulate the flow of traffic in the area creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public safety and welfare of its citizens requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such case provides.
