

## ORDINANCE NO. 1516

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, BY ADDING A SECTION 10-76 THERETO SO AS TO PROHIBIT THE STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING OF VEHICLES AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS WITHIN PUBLIC PARKS OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Mesquite be and is hereby amended by adding a section 10-76 in all other respects to remain in full force and effect said section to read as follows:

"Sec. 10-76. Parking Prohibited - Designated Locations.

When notice is given by the erection of signs, no person shall leave, stop, park or stand a vehicle in the following locations:

Paschall Park. Park roadway located on the West boundary line of the park property and North of New Market Road. Both sides of said roadway from New Market to South Mesquite Creek."


SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

SECTION 3. The fact that the City of Mesquite has no Ordinances regulating the parking of vehicles in public parks, creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.


