ORDINANCE NO. 1540

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 47.5, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ESTABLISHING CERTAIN SCHOOL ZONES; BY PROVIDING THE LOCATION AND TIME OF SAID SCHOOL ZONE AND ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMIT DURING SUCH PERIOD TO BE TWENTY (20) MILES PER HOUR, BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter X, Section 47.5, of the Code of the City of Mesquite is amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following street and portion thereof is hereby designated as a school zone for the school indicated from 7:30 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. and from 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M., and said street and portion thereof is hereby zoned for a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour during such times. Any speed in excess of said maximum shall be prima facie unreasonable and imprudent.

1. To the list of designated streets in Section 10-47.5 the following is added:

LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE

On Military Parkway both for eastbound and westbound traffic from the east curb line of Rollingwood Drive to the west curb line of Glenridge Drive.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances, or portions thereof, of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or

provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Section 47.5 or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 4. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately regulate the speed of an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law and charter in such cases provides.
