AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONING OF A 60-FOOT PUBLIC STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY EXTENDING NORTH-WARD FROM BARNES BRIDGE ROAD A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 887 FEET AT A POINT APPROXI-MATELY 900 FEET WEST OF PALOS VERDES DRIVE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED TO MR. T.C. LUPTON; BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH RIGHT-OF-WAY BE ABANDONED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the herein described 60-foot public street right-of-way extending northward from Barnes Bridge Road a distance of approximately 887 feet at a point approximately 900 feet west of Palos Verdes Drive, City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, shall be, and the same is hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed to T. C. Lupton.

SECTION 3. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires that the right-of-way be abandoned creates an urgency and an emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
