## ORDINANCE NO. 1576

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE OF NAME FOR CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR THE RETENTION OF POSTED SPEED LIMITS ON THE RENAMED STREETS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

WELL SALVE WELL - STATE WITH SEVERE OF THE

SECTION 1. That the indicated streets be and are hereby renamed as follows:

SECTION 2. That the posted speed limits now applicable to the streets or portions herein shall be retained for the renamed streets.

SECTION 3. That the provisions of this ordinance shall be effective as follows:

- (1) Subsections (a), (b), and (c) of Section 1 shall be effective on September 1, 1980.
- (2) Subsections (d) and (e) shall be effective upon the completion and final acceptance by the City of the construction of the Gross Road connection referred to in subsection (e).
- SECTION 4. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite, Texas, do not adequately provide for the orderly identification of newly constructed streets creates an urgency and emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
