

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONING OF UNUSED PUBLIC STREET AND PUBLIC ALLEY RIGHTS-OF-WAY DEDICATED BY PLAT OF MOORE'S RESUBDIVISION OF LOTS 92 AND 93 OF SHERWOOD FOREST, SECOND SECTION, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT-CLAIM DEED TO MR. SAM DONALDSON, THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNER BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH UNUSED PUBLIC STREET AND PUBLIC ALLEY RIGHTS-OF-WAY BE ABANDONED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the herein described abandoning of unused public street and public alley rights-of-way dedicated by plat of Moore's Resubdivision of Lots 92 and 93 of Sherwood Forest, Second Section, City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, shall be, and the same is hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed to Mr. Sam Donaldson, the abutting property owner.

SECTION 3. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires that the unused public street and public alley rights-of-way be abandoned creates an urgency and an emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.


