

ORDINANCE NO. 1640

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES IN SCHOOL ZONES, THE ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be and is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects said chapter and Code to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 10-47.5.

"The following street and portion thereof is hereby designated as a school zone for the school indicated from 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., and said street and portion thereof is hereby zoned for a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour during such times. Any speed in excess of said maximum shall be prima facie unreasonable and imprudent.

1. To the list of designated streets in Section 10-47.5 the following is added:

<u>SCHOOL</u>	<u>LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE</u>
Galloway	Spiceberry from its most westerly intersection with Clary to its most easterly intersection with Saffron Circle.
Rugel	Mount Vernon from Hermitage to Sybil Drive.
Lawrence	Richman Drive from Statler Drive to Rockne Lane.

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Range	Bamboo Street from Emerald Drive to Bahamas Street
Galloway	Candleberry Drive from its most westerly intersection with Clary Drive to Spiceberry Lane.

2. From the list of designated streets in Sec. 10-47.5 the following is deleted.

Galloway	Spiceberry from Clary to Saffron Circle.
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SECTION 10-61.2 - Parking at any time prohibited on certain designated streets

When signs are erected or curbs marked giving notice to such effect, no person shall park or leave standing a vehicle at any time upon the portions of the streets described below:

1. To the list of designated streets in Section 10-61.2 the following is added:

Scyene Road, both sides from the west curblineline of Hickory Tree Road, westerly to the east curblineline of Scyene/Military intersection.

West Main Street, south side from a point 170 feet west of Galloway to Broad Street.

Davis Street, north side from the west curblineline of Broad Street (Town Square) to Gibson Street.

2. From the list of designated streets in Sec. 10-61.2 the following is deleted.

Scyene Road, south side from the west curblineline of Hickory Tree Road, westerly to the east curblineline of the Scyene/Military intersection.

SECTION 10-61.6 - Parking limited to two hours on certain streets

When notice is given by the erection of signs or the marking of curbs to such effect, it shall be unlawful to park or stand a vehicle for a period of more than two (2) hours on the following streets or portions thereof:

1. To the list of designated streets in Section 10-61.6 the following is added:

West Main Street	North side from Galloway to west curblin of Broad Street (Town Square)	7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday thru Saturday
West Main Street	Both sides from Broad Street (Town Square) to Ebrite St.	7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday thru Saturday
Davis Street	South side from Rugel Street to Gibson Street	7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday thru Saturday
Davis Street	North side from Rugel Street to Broad Street (Town Square)	7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday thru Saturday

2. From the list of designated streets in Sec. 10-61.6 the following is deleted:

West Main Street	Both sides, from the west curblin of Lancaster to the east curblin of Ebrite St., except for that area designated in Ordinance No. 1156 as a taxi stand.	7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday thru Saturday
Davis Street	East curblin of Rugel Street to west curblin of Gibson Street.	7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday thru Saturday

SECTION 10-33.12 - Traffic Control Devices

To the list of official traffic control devices in Section 10-33.12 the following is added:

No U-turn signs on Gus Thomasson from IH 30 South Service Road to Town East Boulevard.

No U-turn signs on Town East Boulevard from Gus Thomasson to IH 635 West Service Road.


SECTION 2. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Chapter 10 or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

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SECTION 3. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately regulate the speed of vehicles in school zones, establish official traffic control devices and regulate the parking of vehicles in certain locations creates an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law and charter in such cases provides.


